

# PERSONALITY

*If you are...*

**affectionate** you usually show your love or fondness to other people.

**bossy** you enjoy telling other people what to do.

**cheerful** you are a happy and joyful person and you show this in your behaviour.

**clumsy** you move or handle things in a careless way, often with the result that they are knocked down or broken.

**conceited** you have too high an opinion of yourself.

**cool** you are calm and unemotional rather than angry or excited.

**down-to-earth** you are practical and natural in manner.

**dull** there's nothing interesting or original in you.

**easy-going** you are not easily annoyed, worried, or upset by problems or other people's actions.

**eccentric** you have habits or opinions that other people think strange or peculiar.

**fussy** you are very concerned with unimportant details and are difficult to please.

**good-humoured** you are pleasant and cheerful and enjoy jokes.

**good-natured** you are friendly and don't easily get angry (opposite = bad tempered).

**hard-hearted** you have no sympathy for other people and do not care if people are hurt or feel unhappy.

**hard-working** you like working and don't mind efforts (lazy).

**kind** you are gentle, caring and helpful to other people.

**lively** you are active, enthusiastic and cheerful.

**loyal** you are true and faithful to someone or something (opposite = disloyal, fickle).

**mean** you are unwilling to spend much money (opposite = generous).

**moody** you are depressed or unhappy, and you indicate this by not talking very much or by being impatient to other people.

**nervy** you are usually tense, anxious and get easily upset (opposite = relaxed).

**open-minded** you are willing to listen to and consider other people's ideas and opinions.

**outgoing** you are friendly and speak a lot (extrovert).

**pleasant** you are friendly and nice to other people (opposite = unpleasant).

**polite** you have good manners and behave in a socially correct way (opposite = rude / impolite).

**quiet** you speak very little.

**reserved** you don't like talking about personal feelings or giving very much information about yourself.

**romantic** you have a lot of ideas that have nothing to do with real life, for example about love (idealist) (opposite = realistic).

**rude** you are not at all polite (impolite).

**sensible** you are able to make good decision based on reasons rather than emotions (reasonable).

**sensitive** you are able to understand other people's feelings and problems.

**shy** you feel nervous and uncomfortable in the company of other people (timid).

**sociable** you enjoy being with other people and talking to them.

**stubborn** you are determined to do what you want and very unwilling to change your mind (obstinate).

**sympathetic** you are kind and understand people's feelings.

**tactful** you are careful not to do or say something that would hurt other people's feelings (opposite = tactless).

**talkative** you speak a lot.

**tidy** you like everything to be clean, neat and arranged in an orderly way (opposite = untidy, disorderly).

**tolerant** you allow other people to have their own attitudes and beliefs, or to behave in a particular way, even if you don't agree or approve.

**touchy** you are easily upset, offended and irritated.

**trustworthy** you are reliable and responsible and people can trust you completely (opposite = unreliable).

**vicious** you are cruel and violent.

**witty** you usually say amusing and clever things.
