TYPES OF SENTENCES

- Affirmative

I play tennis in the afternoon.

- Negative

He doesn't watch TV at night.

- Interrogative

Do you write letters?

AFFIRMATIVE

El orden habitual de las oraciones afirmativas es:

SUJETO + VERBO + COMPLEMENTOS

I	played	tennis
He	lives	in Italy
They	are	students
She	has arrived	very late

NEGATIVE

El orden habitual de las oraciones negativas es:

SUJETO + AUXILIAR + NOT + VERBO + COMPLEMENTOS

I	did	not	play	tennis
He	does	not	live	in Italy
They	are	not		students
She	has	not	arrived	very late

INTERROGATIVE

El orden habitual de las oraciones interrogativas es:

AUXILIAR + SUJETO + VERBO + COMPLEMENTOS ?

Did	I	play	tennis ?
Does	he	live	in Italy ?
Are	they		students?
Has	she	arrived	very late ?
